We will also be making the most of cross-curricular links in mathematics and English. These are some of the themes that we will be covering this term:

<b>Mathematics</b>	Fractions, Time and Shape and 2, 4 and 8 times tables.

- Our PE days are **Monday** and **Thursday** and children should come to school in P.E. kit. Please ensure children either remove earrings at home, are able to remove them independently or bring tape to cover them. We are not able to help with the removal of earrings. We also ask that children are able to keep long hair away from their face for P.E.

- We will visit the school library every Tuesday for children to choose a book in addition to their normal reading book.
- We will learn a new spelling pattern each week and these spellings will be available to practise on Spelling Shed. We advise children to go on the Mastery section for tailored spelling lists.
- We will also be learning timetables in school and we encourage the children to practise these on Times Tables Rock Stars.
